Subject: Policy Change for Discharge Permit

Background and Discussion

Staff has been working to secure a Basinwide discharge permit that would facilitate the operation of wells and treatment facilities. Originally, the permit was intended to only address issues in the San Gabriel Valley. However, WQA staff is now recommending that the permit be made available to parties outside the Basin.

Background and Discussion

Stetson Engineers, Inc. (Stetson) has been assisting staff with the research and development of a discharge permit that would be used to facilitate the operation of wells and treatment facilities in the Basin. Staff is now recommending approval of an additional Task Order for Stetson to continue work on the discharge permit. Funding for the Task Order was included in the \$150,000 line item transfer approved by the WQA Board in December 2011.
